






Close-up of Henry Atkinson entry








Plan of Bridlington Cemetry, Sewerby Road, Bridlington






Compartment "Y", showing end of row numbers given to each stone when recorded by East Yorkshire Funeral Memorial Services



Detailed plan of compartment "Y", showing reference numbers from Bridlington Library




